Children and Vandalism Policy

When working on client's sites or within domestic premises, the Company will take all necessary steps to prevent children gaining access to the work areas at all times. Appropriate measures will be taken to ensure the work site may not be utilised as a play area, and so as to prevent vandalism. The occupier of the premises (i.e. the main contractor on most normal sites) is responsible for the safe conduct of its business on that site including the prevention of accidents and injuries to the public, even though they may be trespassing.

Within domestic premises on completion of the day's work, the Company will ensure that work areas should be left safe and secure as not to prevent a hazard. On every site whether enclosed or open to the public (e.g. large housing sites, road works, etc.) it is becoming increasingly necessary to take precautions to prevent vandalism, damage and injury to the public.

Particular attention will be given by the Company, where necessary, to the guarding or covering of excavations and manhole, etc., immobilisation of company vehicles equipment, security of Domestic Gas Supply, security of electricity supply, security of Liquefied Petroleum Gas Supplies, other hazardous substances and prevention of access to working platforms, access equipment and the interior of buildings.
