

CoSHH Incident/Emergency Policy

Bradley Demolition LTD abides by and accepts as a matter of Policy its obligations Under: THE CONTROL OF SUBSTANCES HAZARDOUS TO HEALTH 2002 (COSHH) as amended 2004

The organisation recognises its "legal" duty under the mentioned legislation to ensure that prepared plans and procedures to deal with accidents, incidents and emergencies exist. This will apply where the work activity gives rise to a risk of an accident, incident or emergency involving exposure to hazardous substances which goes well beyond the risks associated with normal day-to-day work.

The organisation will as a matter of policy ensure that "Any" accident, incident or emergency relating to the use of materials/products which come under the mentioned COSHH Regulations will be reported "Immediately" to management without delay.

Policy Priority 1: Information on what the particular accident, incident or emergency is and if possible, details on the substance/product which have been used by the operative or operatives involved with the specification works must be given as soon as is practicable to Management personnel.

Only those staff necessary to deal with the incident may remain in the area and they must be provided with appropriate safety equipment.

Policy Priority 2: The company will conduct 'COSHH Safety Drills' which will be practiced at regular intervals in relation to these regulations.
