Confined space Working Policy

The Company undertakes confined space operations whilst working on client's sites. The [Confined Space Regulations 1997](#) regulations define a confined space as: "Any place, including any chamber, tank, vat, silo, pit, trench, pipe sewer, well or similar space in which, by virtue of its enclosed nature, there arises a reasonably foreseeable specified risk". The Company, before undertaking any confined space work, will arrange for suitable and sufficient arrangements for the rescue of persons and the establishment of a Safe System of Work. All work will be in compliance with the Company's Confined Space Entry Permit System. All persons employed on this type of work will be trained in entry and rescue procedures as determined in the said 1997 Regulations.
