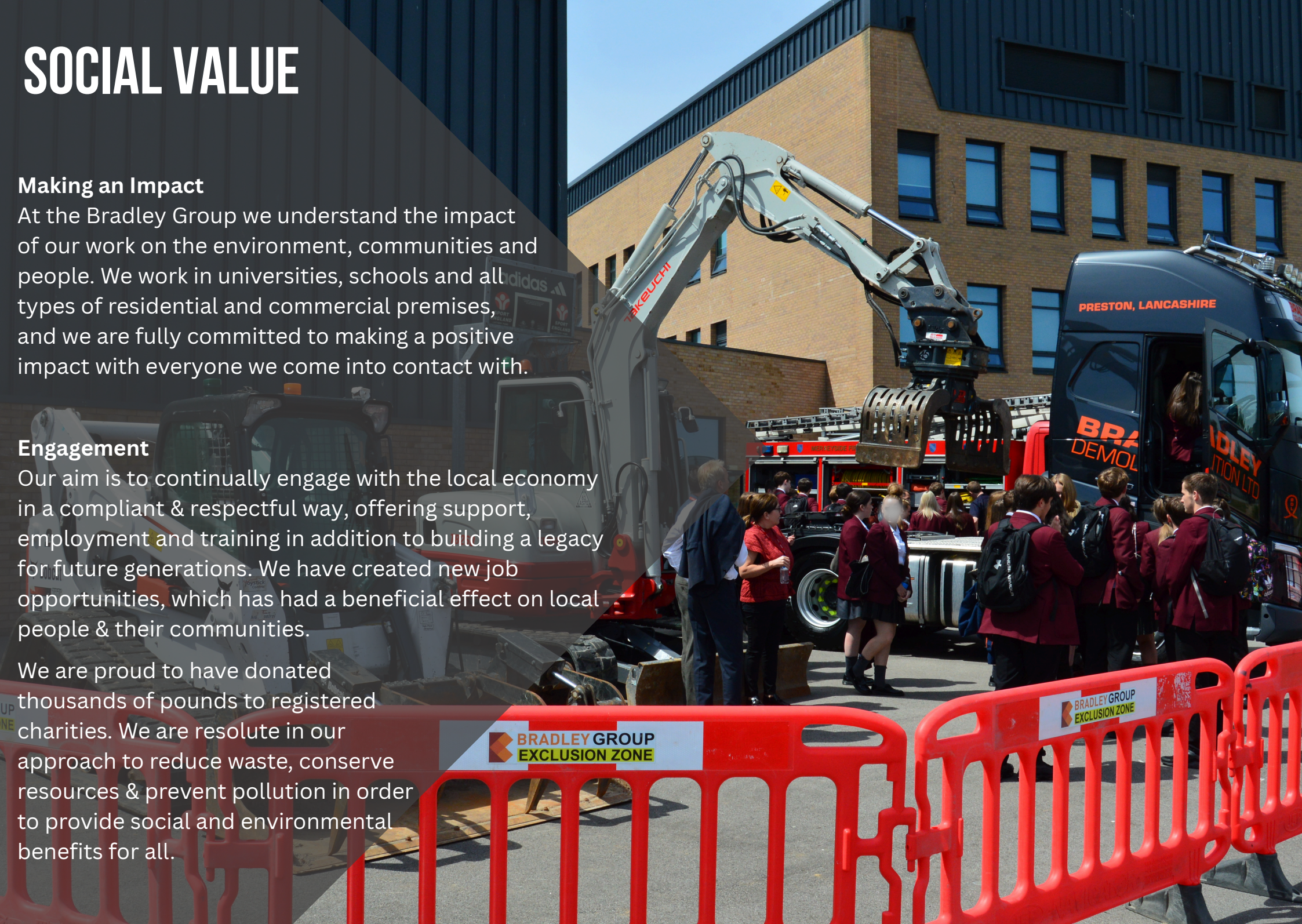

# MANCHESTER AIRPORT T2

## Project Scope:

Works at Terminal 2 of Manchester Airport, consisting of Soft strip demolition, Shell & Core demolition, associated enabling & temporary works, plus site clearance and hazardous waste removal.

**Project Value:** £10,000,000

200,000 man

The scope of works included an extensive soft strip demolition and removal of all materials within the original Terminal 2 structure, reducing the areas back to shell and core. The works required management of sufficient resources to supplement the different phases of the project interfacing with multiple trades to ensure critical target programmes were achieved.

Due to the nature of the works taking place within a Live Airport Environment, additional control measures were in place to mitigate any risk to disruption of Airport activities. The use of extensive modern electrical plant minimised the environmental impact of the works and contributed to our Net zero carbon neutral project goals.



# PRESTON MARKET

## Project Scope:

Asbestos Removal & Demolition of the former Preston indoor market and multi-storey car park and associated works.

Bradley Group were contracted to complete the Demolition of the Preston Indoor Market and Multi-Storey Car Park in preparation for the new 'Animate' development on the site. Works included site hoarding, internal soft stripping, asbestos removal, temporary road closures, main services terminations, drainage works, reinstatement works. Preston Council is regeneration project was to build a £50million cinema and restaurant complex, along with a new car park



# MANCHESTER TOWN HALL

## Project Scope:

Major soft strip package including the methodical dismantling and removal of non-heritage items.

**Project Value:** £8,500,000

Manchester City Council embarked on a major programme to repair and restore the Grade 1 listed Manchester Town Hall. Opened in 1877, The Town Hall is an internationally significant landmark of English heritage, considered to be one of the masterpieces of Victorian architecture.

Bradley Group were tasked with a major soft strip package, which involved the methodical dismantling and removal of non-heritage items. This was to occur alongside concurrent work packages, live services, live transit routes, Grade 1 listed heritage items and the adjacent live Town hall extension offices.

Additional works included - MEP strip out, asbestos removal, plaster removal, bridge demolition and structural alterations.

Decommissioning and Demolition of former Magnox Nuclear Fuel Production Plant & Associated Works

Bradley Group were contracted by Shepley Engineering for the Asbestos Removal and Mechanical Demolition of the 30,000 m2 production facility at Springfields in Salwick, Lancashire. Throughout the demolition process, stringent controls were enforced and all necessary permits had to be obtained prior to any work being conducted. Additionally, Bradley's site personnel were required to undergo specialised nuclear safety training and adhere to enhanced protocols to ensure compliance with regulatory standards and maintain a safe working environment.
